- The bedside open cabinet is securely fixed and highly durable, minimizing the risk of dismantling and ensuring long-term use.
- Designed to align with floor skirting and mounted tightly to the wall to eliminate hiding spaces.
- Carefully crafted with rounded corners to reduce the risk of injury, create a calm appearance, and offer a practical surface for everyday use.

The Roya bedside open cabinet is especially suitable for youth care, residential care facilities, and correctional environments. It is a compact and robust alternative to the Roya bedside table [link], offering slightly more storage while maintaining the same high level of safety. The solid construction and fixed mounting provide excellent stability, reduce the risk of parts being used as weapons, and support long-lasting durability. The design language is intentionally developed to convey a harmonious and calming impression. The furniture is made from plywood, ensuring strength and durability. The laminated surface is scratch-resistant, easy to clean, and retains its appearance over time. Crafted using traditional joinery and gluing methods, the structure is strong and stable, without visible fittings or loose components. This enhances both safety and durability over time. The plywood edges are shaped with broad curves, creating rounded corners that minimize the risk of injury in the event of a fall. Fixed mounting also prevents any components from being removed and used as weapons. The name Roya is derived from the Persian word for dream and sleep – reflected in the furniture's soft and harmonious lines. Its sibling series Aram features a more geometric design language. Design: Healsafe Interior. Recommended placement: patient rooms.

Material

Frame made of plywood with a laminated surface.

Maintenance

Clean the surface with a mild liquid detergent and a soft, clean cloth using circular motions. Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft cloth. For more persistent dirt, a soft nylon brush may be used in the same manner. Alcohol-based disinfectants can be used on laminated surfaces when needed. Never use abrasive cleaners or coarse tools such as scouring pads, as these may scratch and damage the surface. Regularly check that all visible screws are properly tightened and that no gaps have formed.

Sustainability

The product is made of plywood, a strong and durable material that ensures long service life. The laminated surface is scratch-resistant, easy to clean, and maintains its appearance over time – making it a sustainable and practical choice for demanding environments. The plywood can be recycled as wood.

Delivery

The furniture is custom-built in close collaboration with the client to suit the needs of each specific environment. Products can be adapted to existing spaces, and a wide range of laminate options is available. Optional visualization of the furniture based on your room dimensions is available upon request. Warranty

The warranty period for our products made from laminated plywood with treated edges is 2 years from the delivery date. During this period, the warranty covers manufacturing defects, material faults, and issues related to the surface treatment. The warranty also applies to installation-related issues if the product has been installed by Healsafe Interior appointed or in-house installers. The warranty covers the following areas:

Manufacturing defects: Any issues arising from defective production or materials
Delamination: Separation of laminate layers due to faulty adhesives or processes
Surface treatment: Peeling, staining, or deterioration in appearance caused by treatment faults
