CARE GUIDANCE FOR OUR FURNITURE

Our safety furniture is developed to meet the high standards required in challenging environments, as well as in therapeutic and healing environments. To ensure the furniture's durability, function, and safety, it is important that it is cared for properly. Below you will find recommendations for cleaning, maintenance, and handling that help extend the lifespan and preserve the qualities of the furniture over time.

HIGHLAND FABRIC


- Vacuum and wipe regularly using a microfiber cloth lightly dampened with cold water only.
- Blot spills immediately with an absorbent, dry cloth to prevent staining.
- Remove bodily fluids and heavy soiling without delay.
- For persistent stains, a 5% hypochlorite solution may be used. (Note: Hypochlorite can react with organic matter and form harmful chlorine compounds. Use with caution and always follow the manufacturer's gui delines.)
- Avoid solvents, alcohol, or other chemical cleaning agents. If required, use sparingly, as such substances may reduce the product's lifespan.
- Vinyl fabrics may, over time, develop cracks or a sticky surface a known material characteristic reported by fabric manufacturers. As a distributor, we cannot assume responsibility for this.
- Water-resistant fabrics have limited elasticity, which may cause slight wrinkling (puckering) on certain models. This is normal and can occur both during production and after extended use as the fabric stretches.
- Do not use steam cleaning heat may set stains permanently.
- Please note that liquids may penetrate seams and zippers.

ASTON FABRIC

- Wipe regularly with a microfiber cloth lightly dampened with cold water only, then dry with a clean, absorbent cloth.
- Blot spills immediately with a dry, absorbent cloth to prevent staining.
- If dirt has accumulated, use a mild, non-alkaline cleaning agent. Ensure all soap residue is removed and dry with a clean, absorbent cloth.
- Remove bodily fluids and heavy soiling without delay.
- In extreme cases, a 10% bleach (hypochlorite) solution may be used. (Note: Hypochlorite solutions can react with organic matter and form harmful chlorine compounds. Use with caution and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.) Remove all residue and dry thoroughly with a clean, absorbent cloth.
- Avoid solvents, alcohol, or other chemical cleaners. If necessary, use sparingly, and wipe off any excess immediately with a dry cloth, as such substances may reduce the product's lifespan.
- Vinyl fabrics may develop cracking or stickiness over time a known material issue reported by fabric suppliers. As a distributor, we cannot accept responsibility for this.
- Water-resistant fabrics have limited elasticity, which may result in slight wrinkling (puckering) on certain models. This is normal and can occur both during production and after extended use as the fabric stretches.
- Do not steam clean heat may set stains permanently.
- Please note that liquids may penetrate seams and zippers.
- Be aware that dyes and pigments from indigo jeans, ballpoint pens, and markers may cause permanent staining.

DACOR FABRIC

- We recommend cleaning this product using only water and mild soap. Cleaning agents containing alcohol, solvents, bleach, or abrasive substances may damage the material.
- Avoid solvents, alcohol, or other chemical cleaners. If necessary, use sparingly, and wipe off any excess immediately with a dry cloth, as such substances may reduce the product's lifespan.



FURNISHINGS IN MELAMINE-FACED CHIPBOARD (MFC)

- Wipe the surface with a dry or damp clean cloth.
- Spills should be removed immediately using a soft cloth or sponge dampened with warm soapy water or a mild household detergent.
- Wipe with a damp cloth to remove any soap or cleaner residue, then dry the surface with an absorbent paper towel or microfiber cloth.
- Avoid the following cleaning products: abrasive or scouring agents (e.g. scouring pads, steel wool), polishes, detergents, furniture cleaners, bleach, cleaners with strong acids or acidic salts, or steam cleaning. These may damage the surface.
- Avoid products that leave residues, such as waxes or oils.
- Do not place hot objects directly on the surface, as this may cause discoloration.
- Regularly check that all visible screws are tightened and that no gaps have formed.

Ryno®

- Keep the furniture clean by wiping it with a soft cloth.
- Use mild household detergents, degreasers, or antibacterial cleaners for effective cleaning.
- Avoid abrasive materials and cleaning agents, as these may scratch or damage the surface.
- Do not use steam cleaners or pressure washers, as they may cause surface damage.
- Solvents should be avoided, as they can pose a risk of surface degradation.
- Use bleach and chlorine-based disinfectants with caution, as they may negatively affect the surface.
- Do not place the furniture near heat sources to prevent material damage.
- Extreme temperature changes (e.g. a cold night followed by a hot sunny day) may cause the air inside the product to expand, leading to temporary changes in shape.

ROYA & ARAM – FIXED FURNITURE

- Clean using a mild liquid detergent and a clean, soft cloth, gently wiping the surface in circular motions.
- Rinse with clean water and dry the surface with a soft, clean cloth.
- For deeper dirt, a soft nylon brush can be used with circular motions to remove the buildup.
- If disinfection is needed, alcohol-based disinfectants may be used on laminate surfaces.
- Avoid using disinfectants on lacquered edges. Instead, use a lightly damp cloth or a mild cleaning agent.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or rough cleaning tools such as scouring pads or scrubbing discs, as they may leave visible scratches or shiny spots on the surface. Abrasives and rough tools can damage the surface and affect its appearance over time.
- Regularly check that all visible screws are tightened and that no gaps have formed.
